Weekly work schedule/ After Hours / On-call: The clinic is open from Mon-Fri. From 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some physicians also provide evening clinics. We schedule patients both in person and virtually using 20-minute appointment times.

We have kids and understand the meaning of a balanced, flexible lifestyle. The On-Call schedule includes one weekday (in clinic/ overnight) and one weekend (Friday 5 p.m. - Sunday 8 a.m.) and is compensated through both the MOCAP and APP contracts.

Each full-time position is for 1,680 hours annually. Most practitioners choose to meet the hourly commitment by working four days a week. We work collaboratively to develop clinician schedules that work for everyone on the team. Half-time will be considered to allow you to pursue other professional interests.

Practice Description

Type of Practice: The Gabriola Medical Clinic, comprised of five independent practitioners, is a patient medical home. We provide a team-based approach to full-scope family practice. The clinic is also home to a mental health team, Community Health Services, and public health. No sub-specialties are required.

Patient Panel: Approximately 60% of the Gabriola Clinic patients are over 60 years. 38.32% of attached patients have complex care needs and 10% have a mental health diagnosis.
